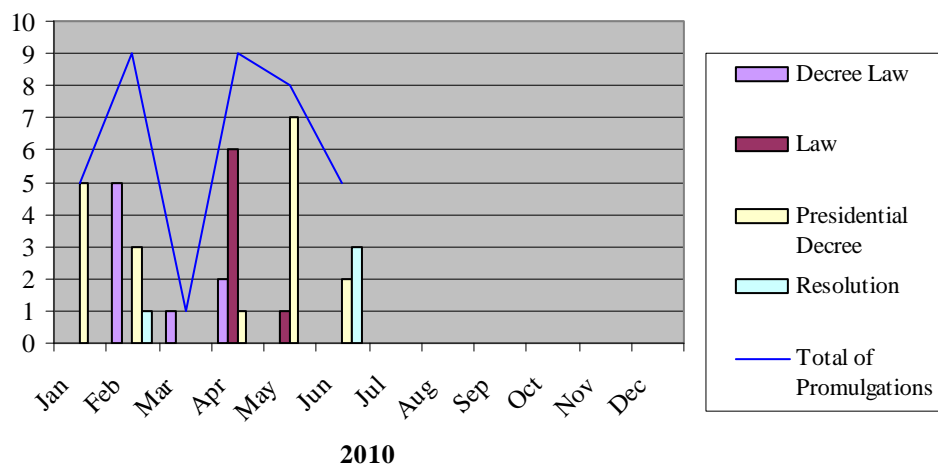

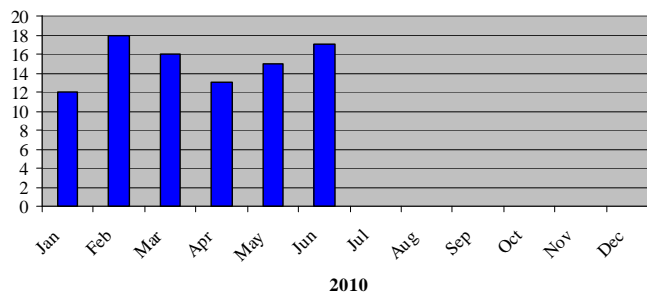

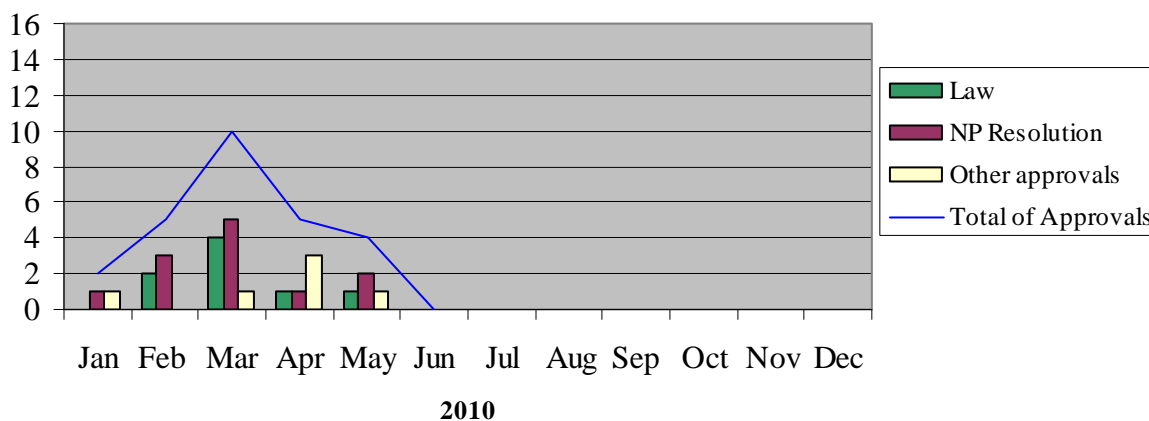

In June 2010, the National Parliament held nine⁴ plenary sessions.

 - Discussion on the National Parliament Rectifying Budget for 2010

Secretary of State for Natural Resources

- Result: Approved with 37 votes in favour, 1 against and 17 abstentions.

Secretary of State for Vocational Training and Employment

- Result: Approved with 33 votes in favour, 18 against and 6 abstentions.

Secretary of State for Energy Policy

- Result: Approved with 33 votes in favour, 0 against and 14 abstentions.

Secretary of State for the Promotion of Equality

- Result: Approved with 47 votes in favour, 0 against and 5 abstentions.

Secretary of State for Defence

- Result: Approved with 32 votes in favour, 4 against and 14 abstentions.

Secretary of State for Security

- Result: Approved with 36 votes in favour, 5 against and 7 abstentions.

Ministry of Defence and Security

- Result: Approved with 33 votes in favour, 2 against and 4 abstentions.

- 30 June 2010:

- Discussion and voting in specialty of the PPL 37/II (First modification to the Law 15/2009 of 23 December approving the 2010 General State Budget for the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste)

Ministry of Foreign Affairs

- Result: Approved with 44 votes in favour, 0 against and 8 abstentions.

Ministry of Finance

- Result: Approved with 38 votes in favour, 15 against and 4 abstentions.

Ministry of Justice

- Result: Approved with 34 votes in favour, 13 against and 7 abstentions.

Ministry of Health

- Result: Approved with 45 votes in favour, 1 against and 5 abstentions.

Extraordinary Activities of the Parliament

14 June 2010:

- Parliament launched local division for anti-corruption organization – “Global Organization of Parliamentarian Against Corruption” (GOPAC). MP Fernanda Borges will chair the Group.

Main issues raised in the plenary sessions:

1. Agreement signed between the Government and ENSUL¹⁰:
 - Minister of Economy and Development and the Ministry of Justice should clarify the agreement signed between the Government and ENSUL for a period of 99 years.
 - Committee C should look at this agreement and analyze in the perspective of the Law on Investment.
2. Lack of conditions of the public toilets serving the touristic area around the statue of the Pope John Paul II (Tasi Tolu).
3. Follow-up to the letter Committee B sent to the Secretary of State for Security to authorize the Commander of Dili District Police or the General Commander of PNTL to come to Parliament and explain regarding what’s happening in Atauro.
4. Importance of promoting the local production of rice as this affects the lives of the Timorese people.
5. Ongoing construction in the areas of Cristo Rei and Tasi Tolu despite the fact that these have been considered protected areas.
6. Contracts signed by the government should be made public as they use the state money.
7. Martial Arts Law must be implemented as soon as possible.
8. Security situation in Ermera:
 - The newspaper Suara Timor Lorosae mentions that an illegal group uses torture and intimidation; MP Rui Menezes (PD) asked the General Commander of PNTL to come to the Parliament to provide clarifications on this matter.
 - Declarations of General Commander of PNTL and his Deputy are not in line and should be clarified.
9. Government should focus on the rights of the children (in reference to the World Children’s Day, 1 June 2010).
10. Lack of water in Dili (Sucos Taibesi and Becora).
11. Commission of Enquiry on rice:
 - MPs Arsénio Bano (FRETILIN) mentioned the report was submitted to the Secretariat on 14 March 2010 but there were no developments so far.
 - The President of the National Parliament informed the report did not fill in the criteria defined in the Commission of Enquiry Law and it has been sent back to the Commission of Enquiry for further discussion before submission to the Plenary.

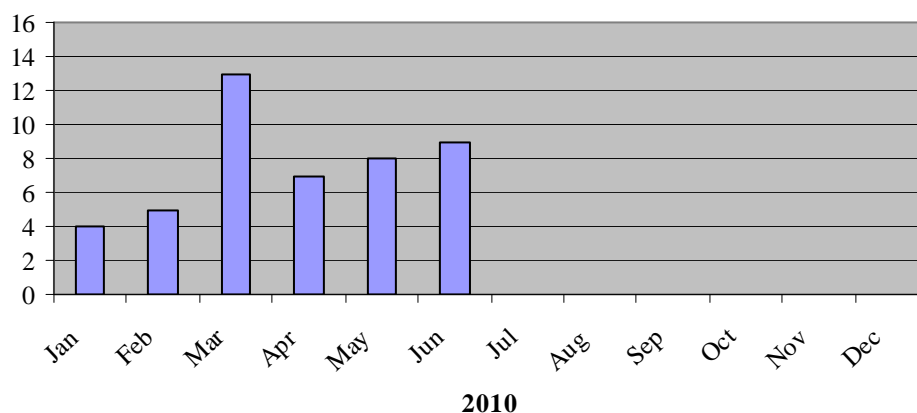

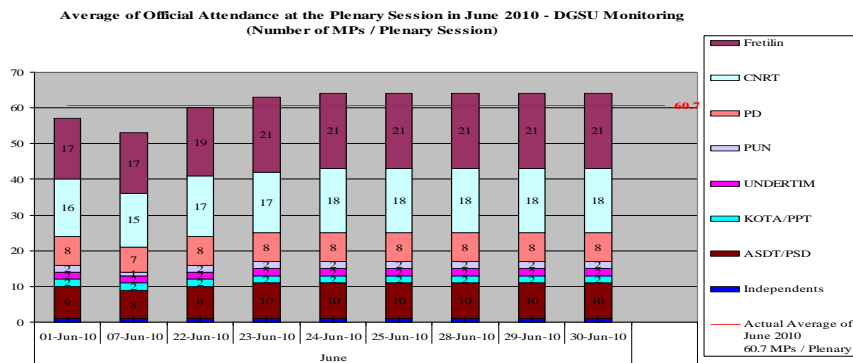

In addition, article 5 of the National Parliament Rules of Procedure states that. “A Member of Parliament who is to absent himself or herself for more than three consecutive days on substantiated grounds may, through his or her political party, submit a request for an early justification of absence and temporary replacement of office”.

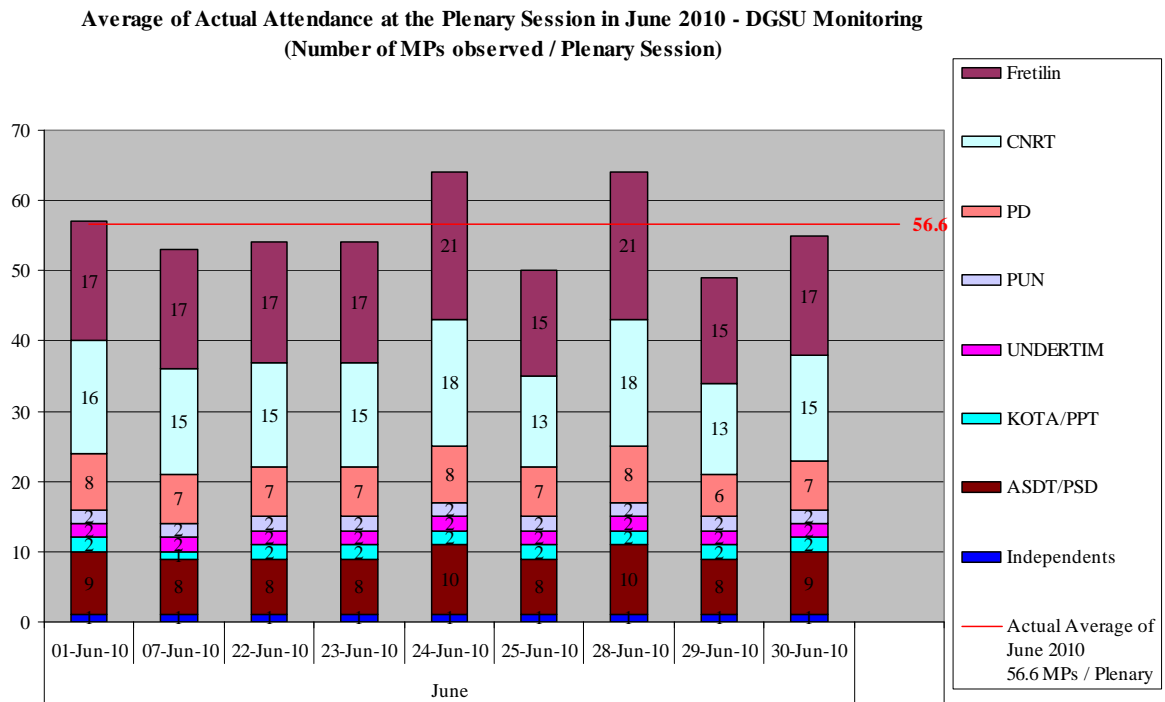

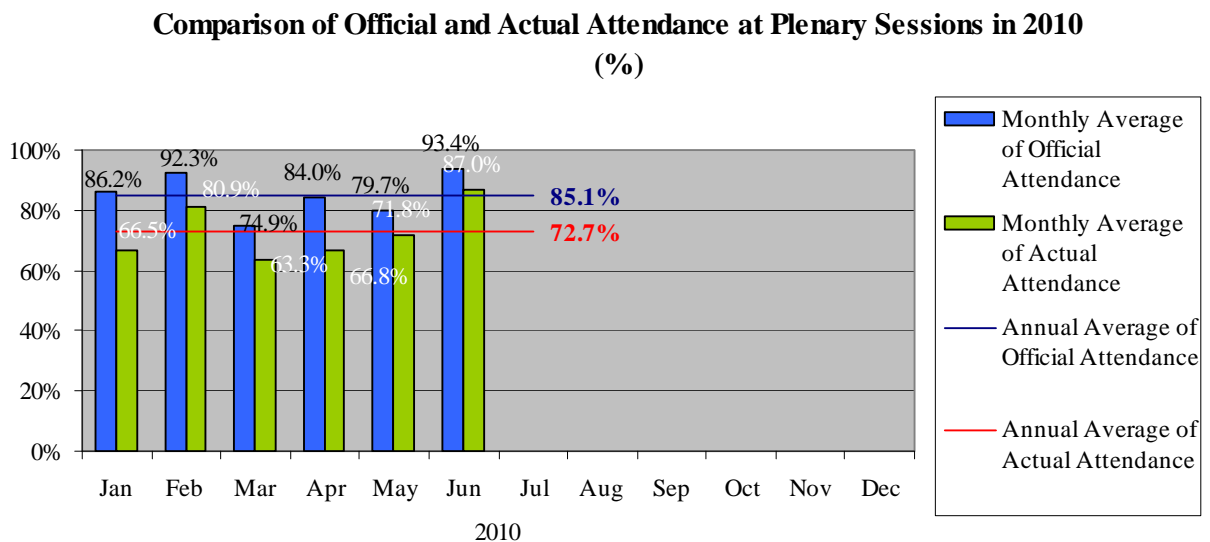

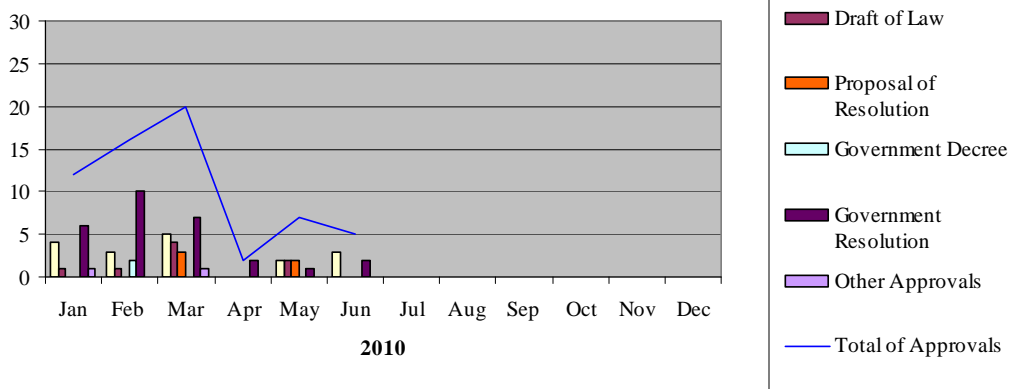

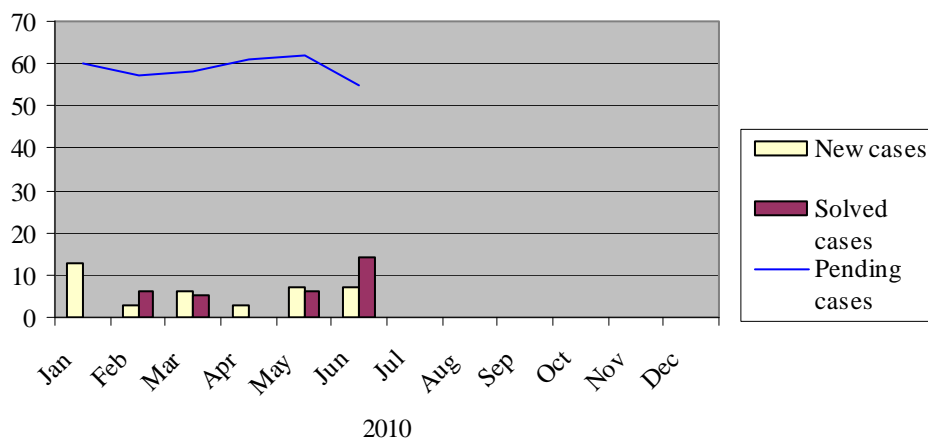

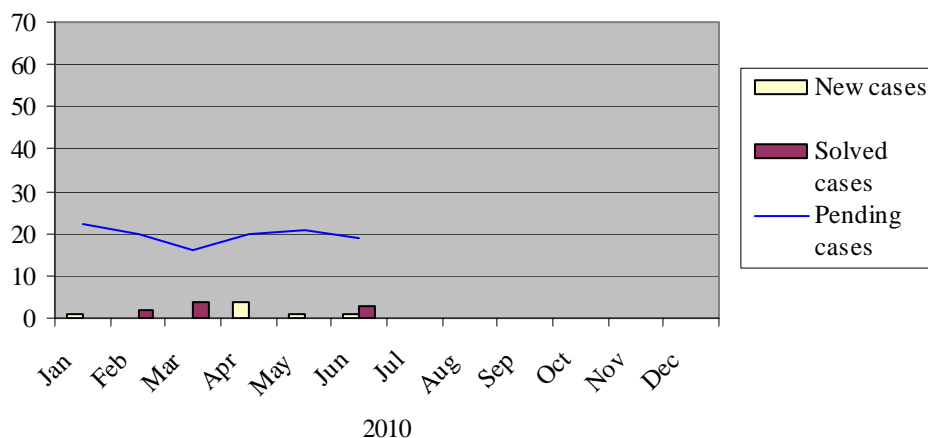
Penal Cases at the Court of Appeal in 2010

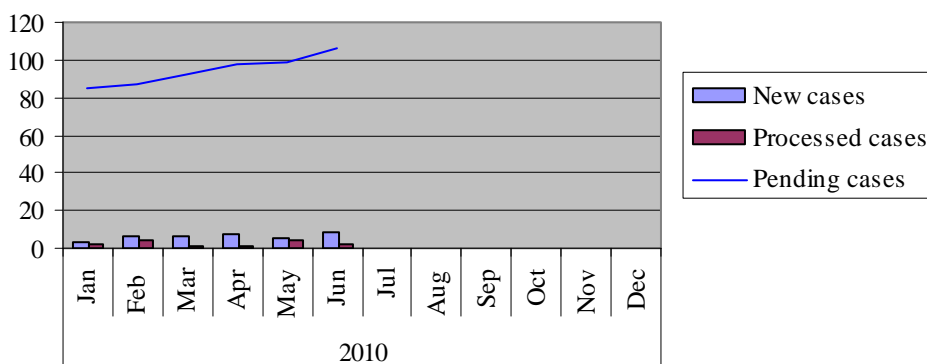

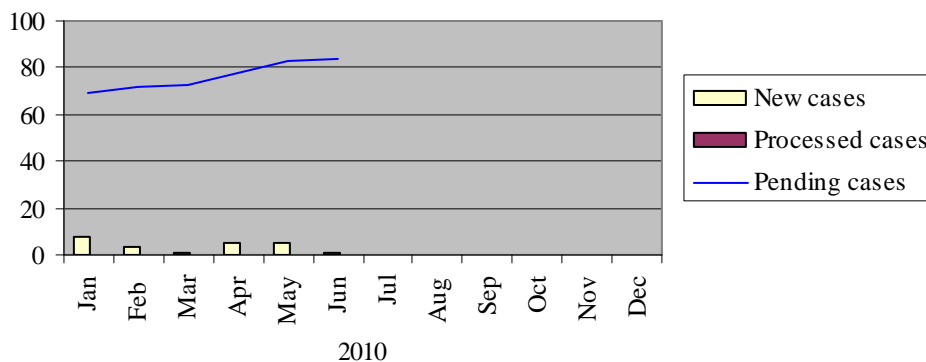

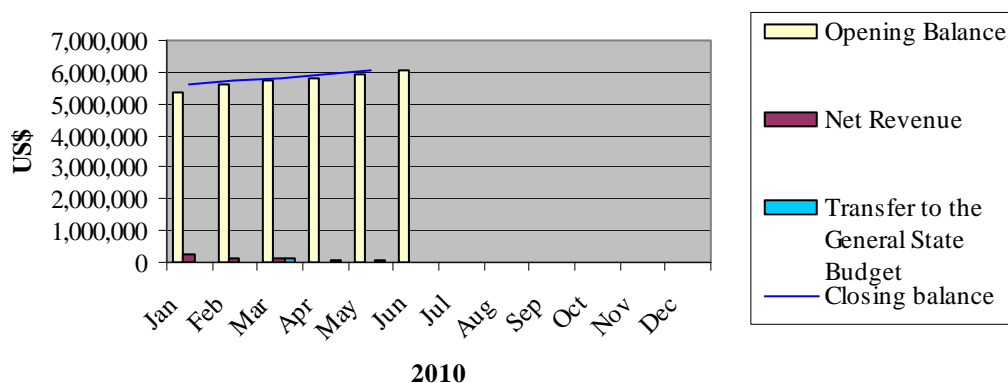

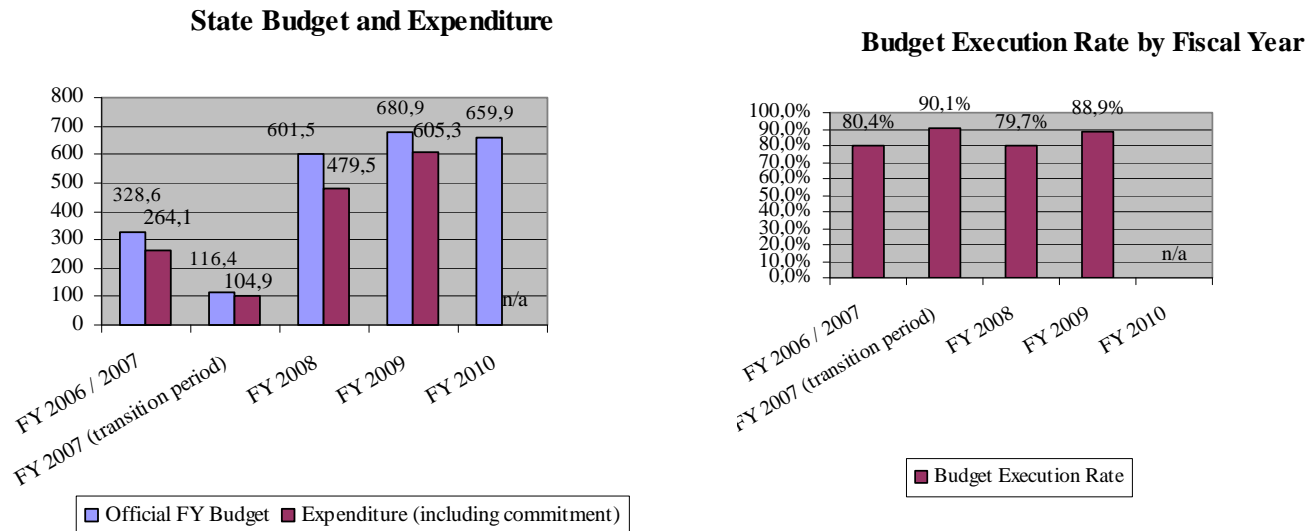

STATE BUDGET EXPENDITURE AND EXECUTION RATE

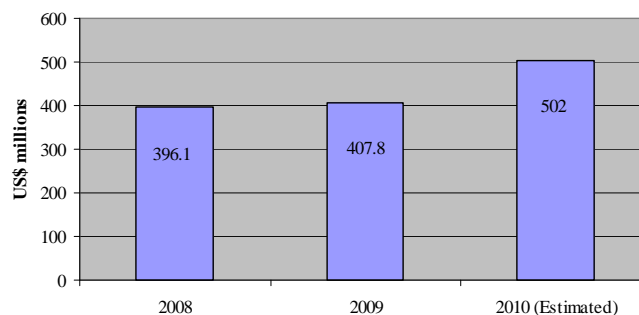


The following charts represent the State budget expenditure and execution rate since the 2006 fiscal year.³⁸

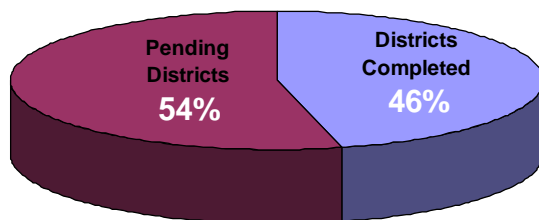

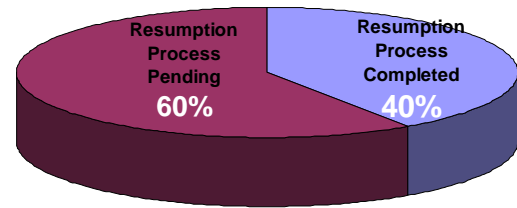

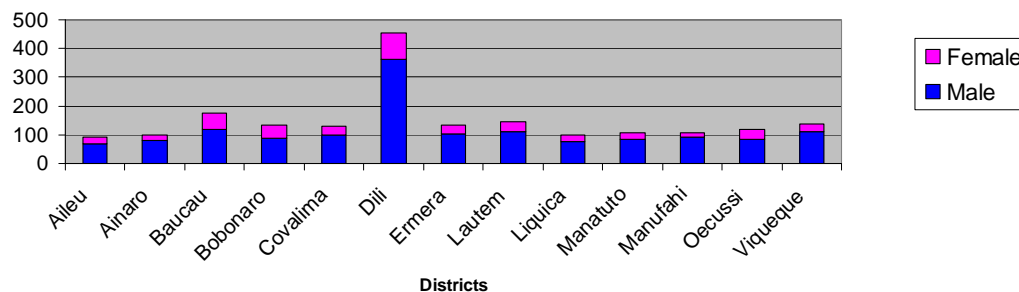
Status of Resumption Process based on the Number of Districts

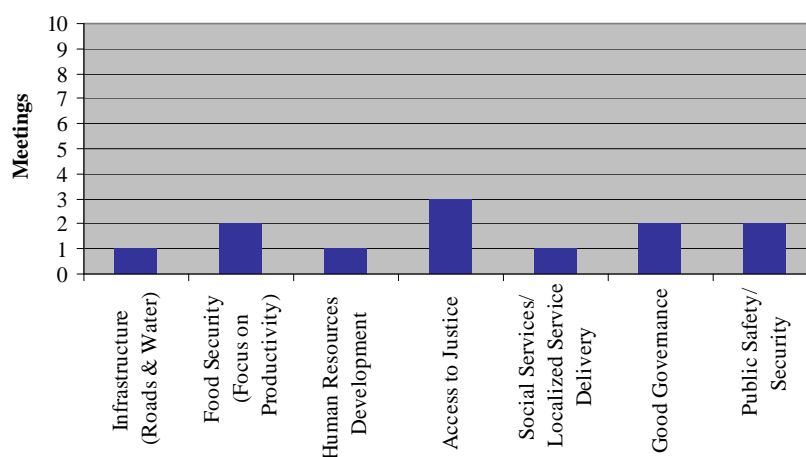

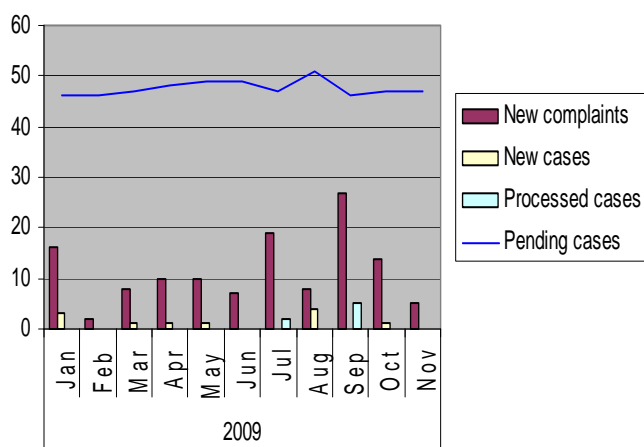

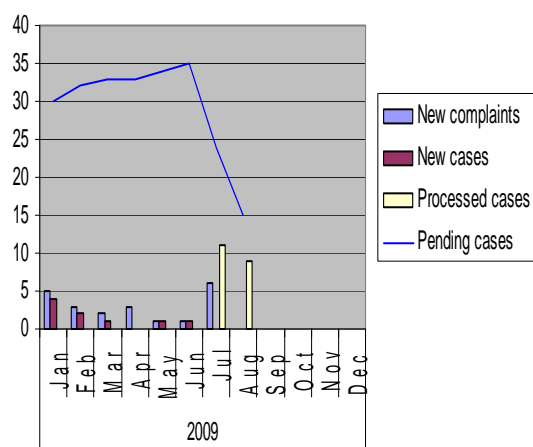

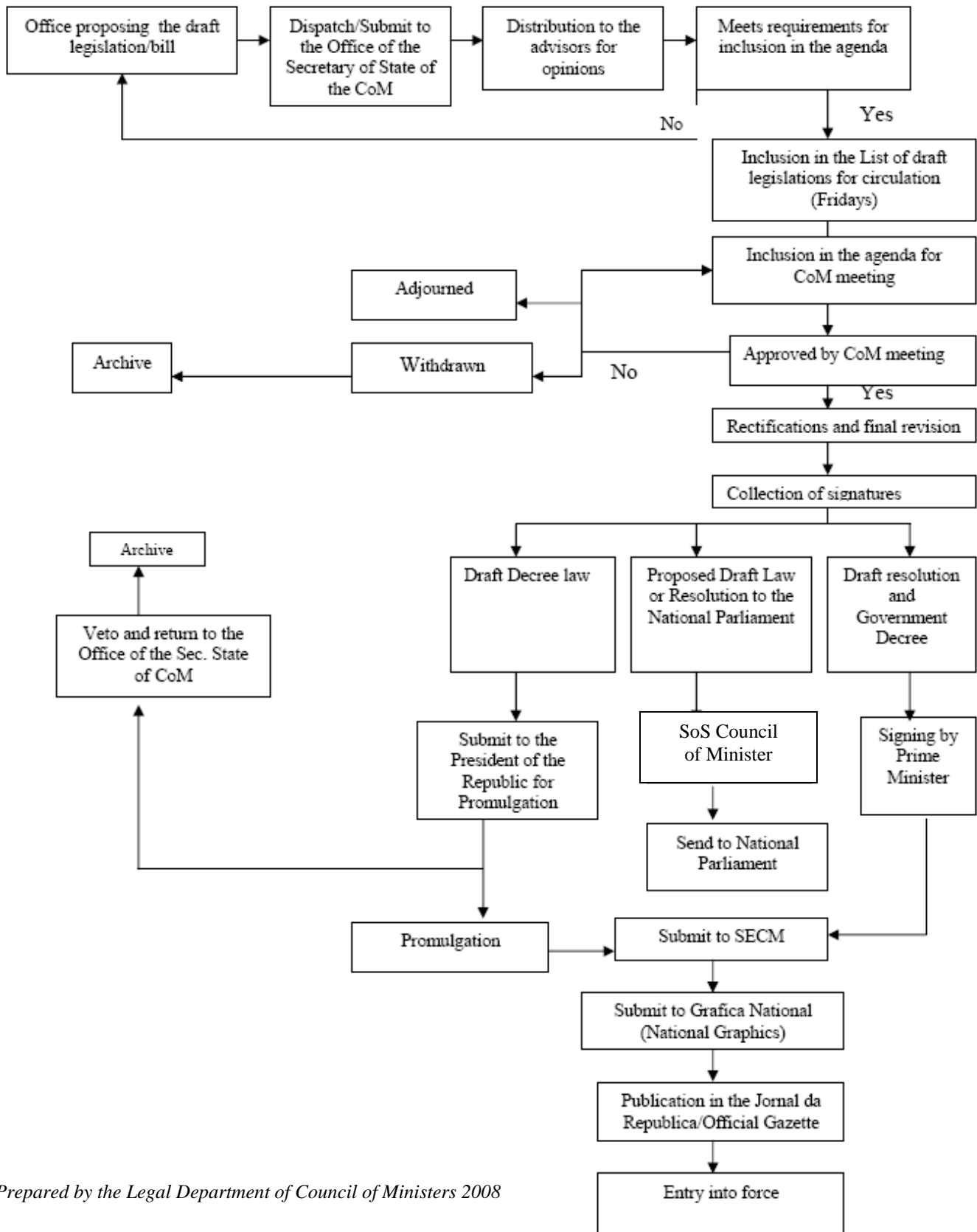

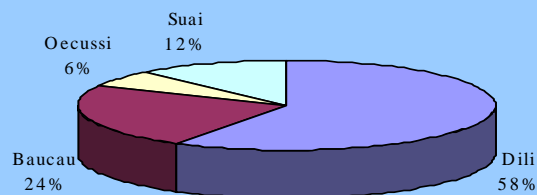

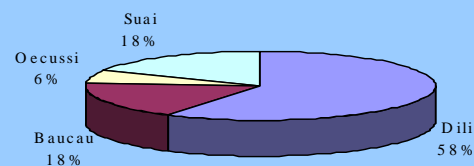
Allocation of National Judges by District Courts



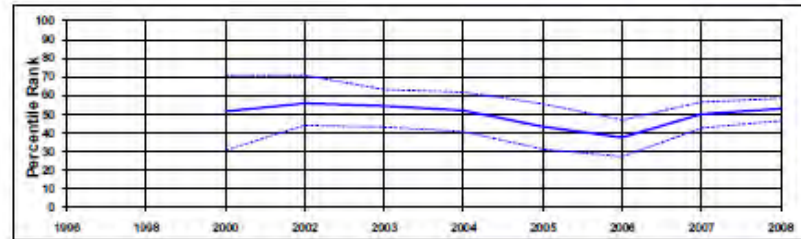
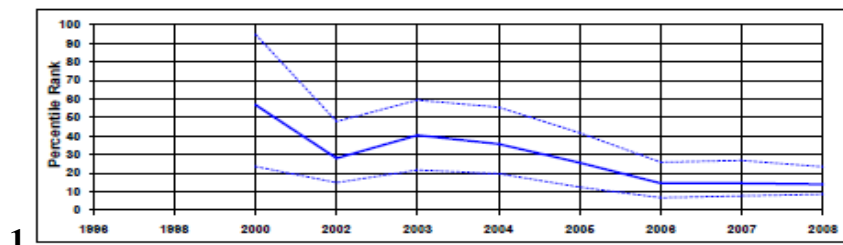
Allocation of National Public Defenders by District Courts



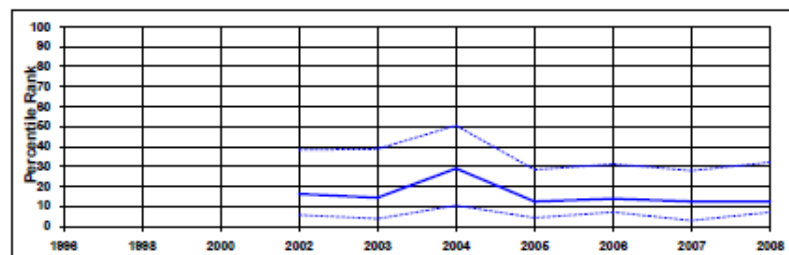
Allocation of National Prosecutors by District Courts

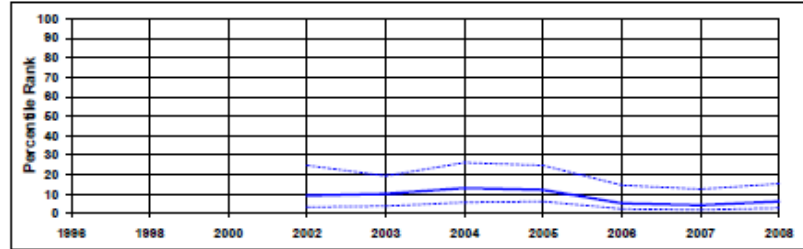

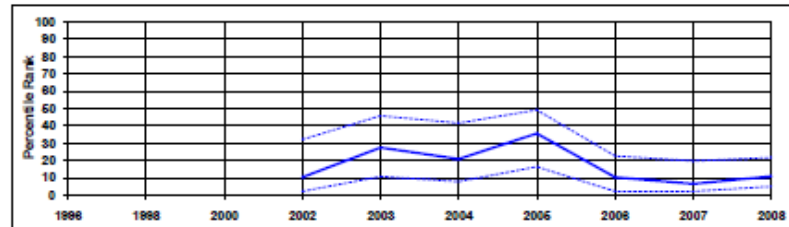

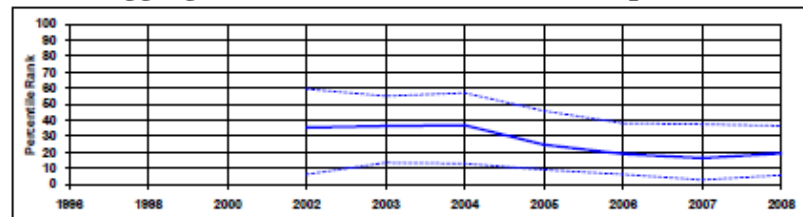
Aggregate Indicator: Regulatory Quality⁷⁸

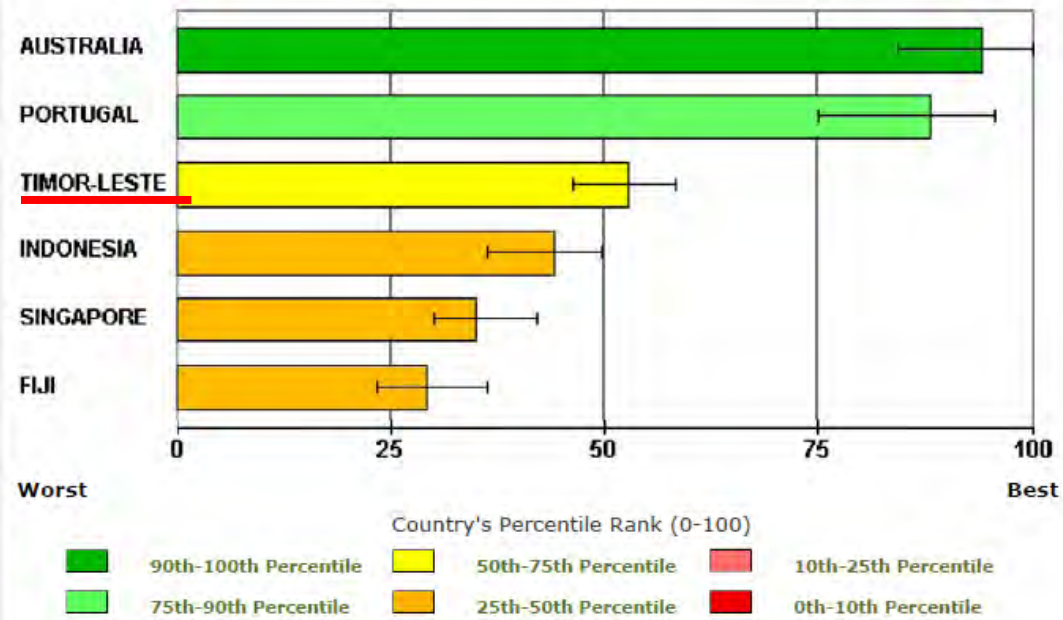

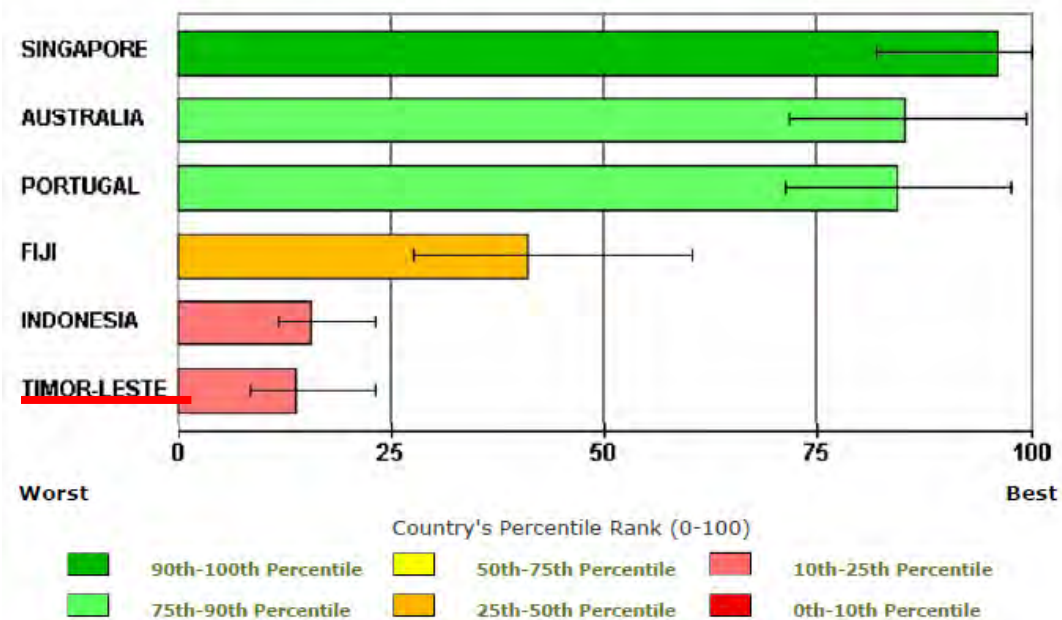

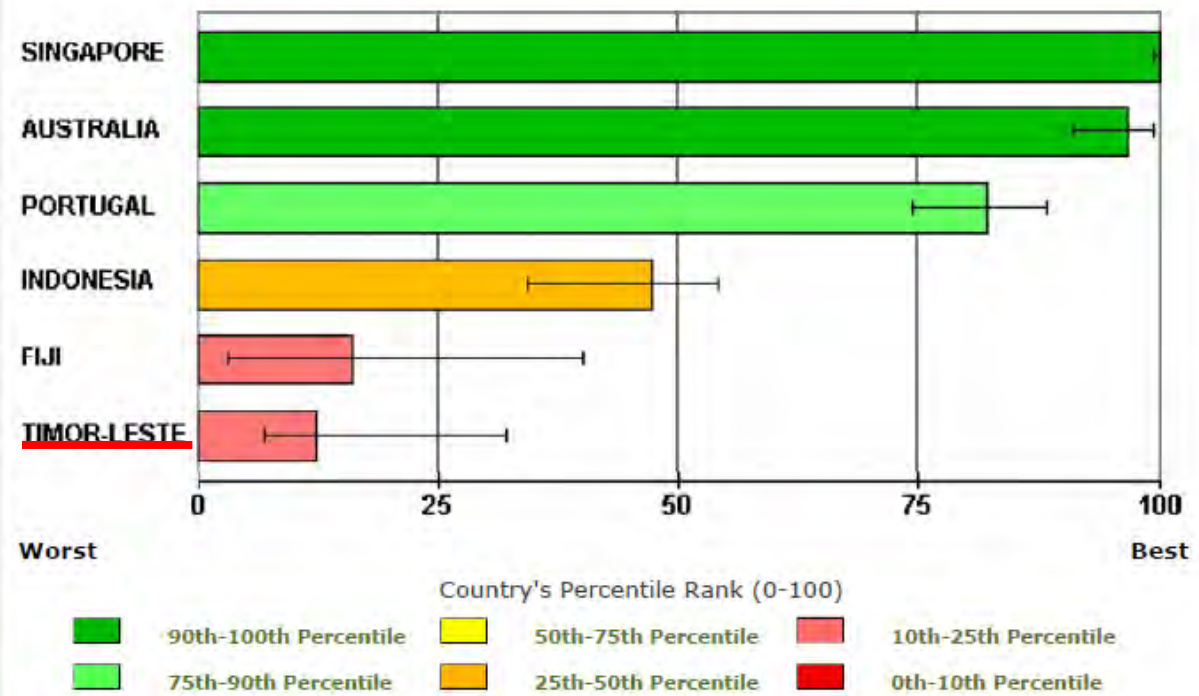
Political Stability(2008)

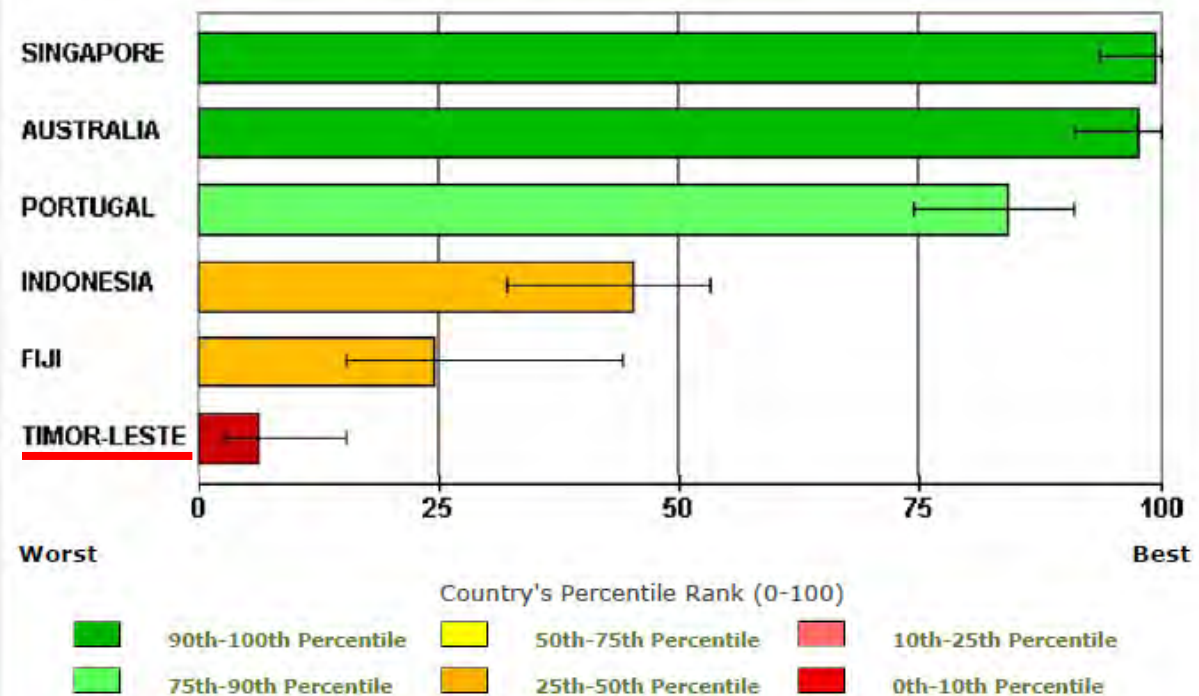
Government Effectiveness(2008)

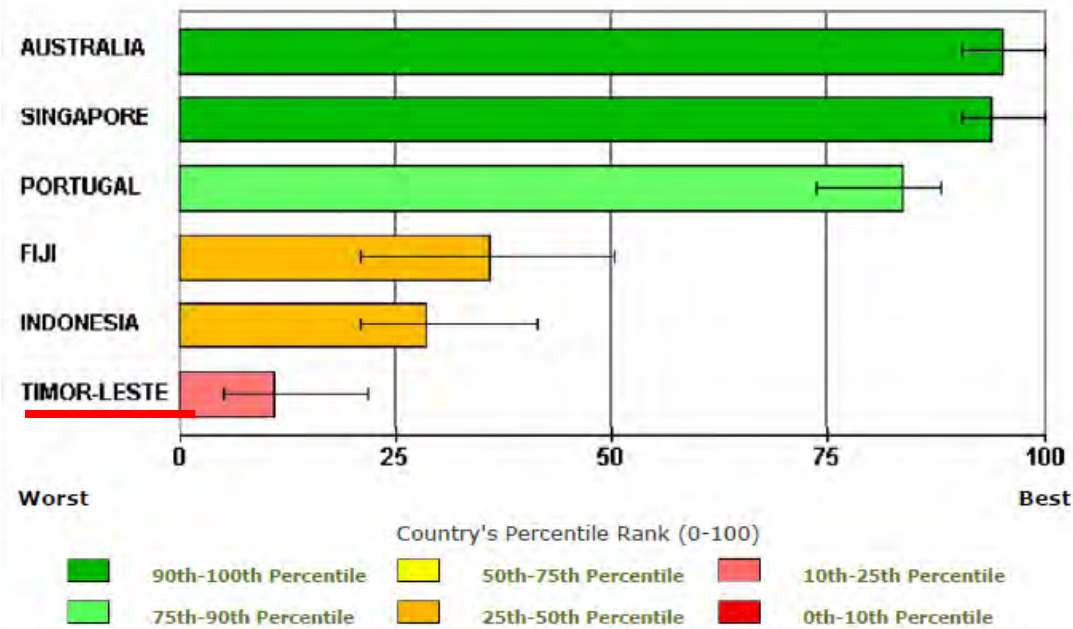
Regulatory Quality(2008)

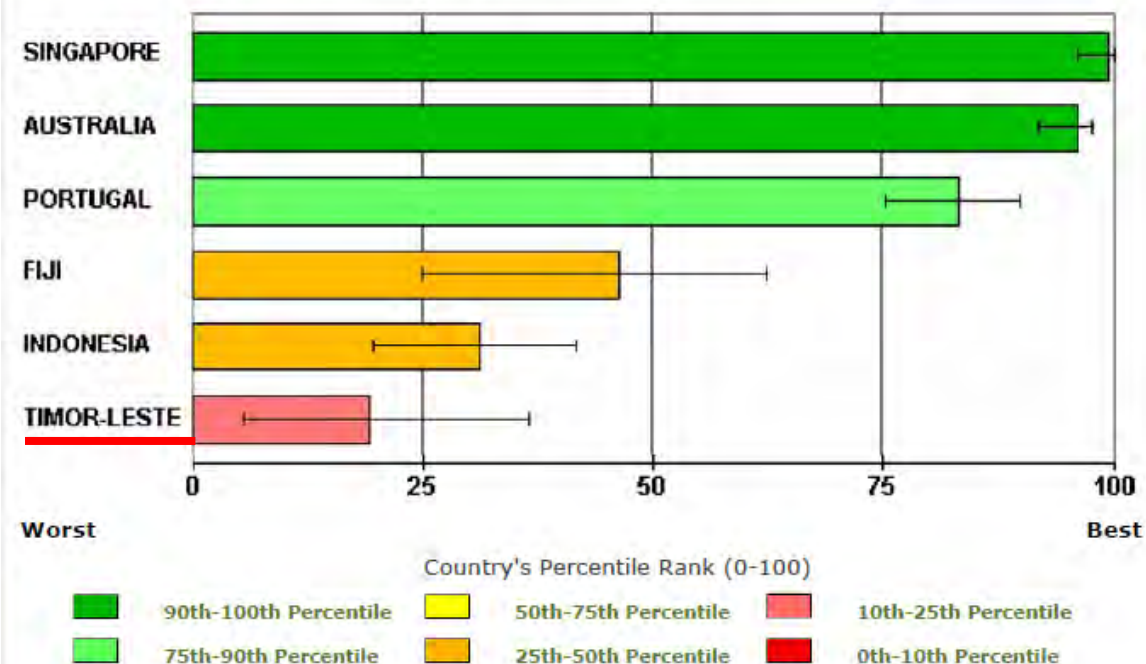


Rule of Law(2008)

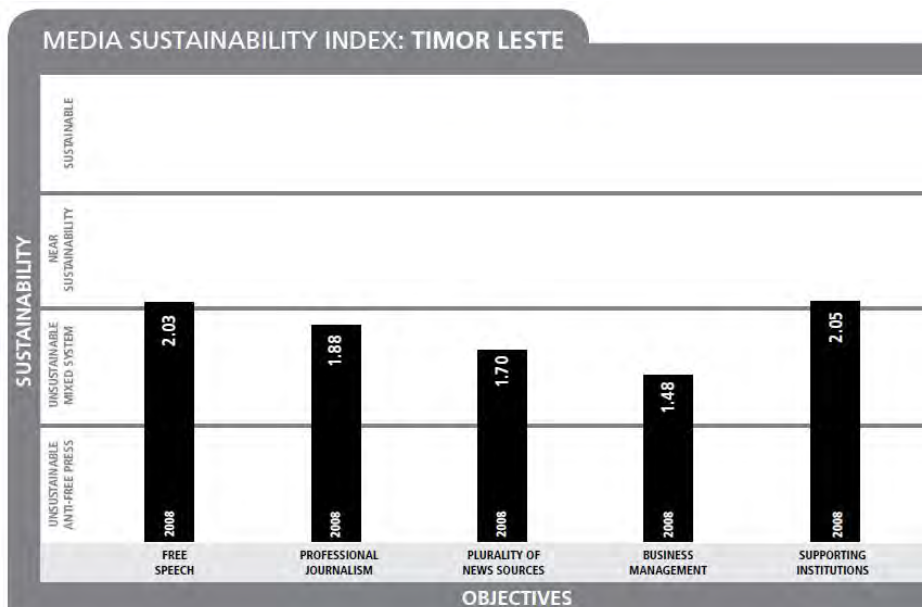

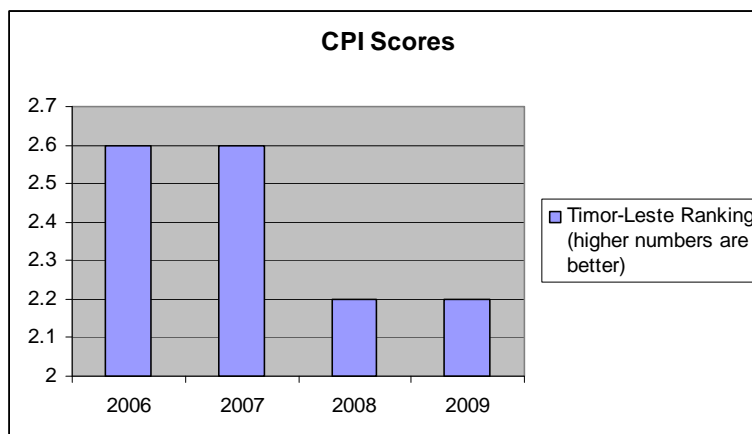
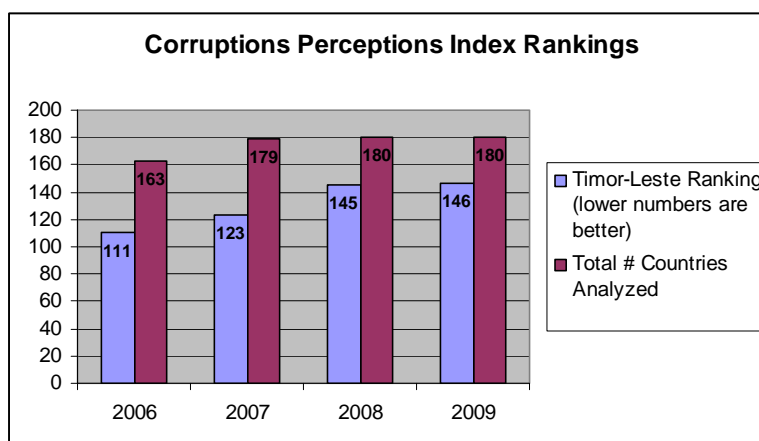

P	PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION	In organic or subjective sense, Public Administration is the set of State bodies, services and agents, as well as the further public legal persons, which ensures the satisfying of various collective needs, such as security, culture, health and the wellbeing of the populations. A person employed by Public Administration is called a civil servant. It can also be defined objectively as the concrete and immediate activity that States develop for ensuring collective interests, and subjectively as the set of legal bodies and persons to which the Law attributes the exercise of the administrative function of the State. Under the operational aspect, Public Administration is the perennial and systematic, legal and

		technical development of the services belonging to the State, benefiting the whole.
	PROMULGATION	Internal legal act by which the President of the Republic attests the existence of a duly ratified law, Decree-Law, treaty, etc., and order its execution within the territory. It is important to highlight the difference, in practical terms, between the effects of ratification and those of promulgation. If a State ratifies a treaty but does not promulgate it (and if its constitutional law requires promulgation), the conventional text is mandatory in the international sphere but not in the internal one. In this case, the State in question may be asked by other Contracting Parts to fulfill some of its conventional obligations, but one of its internal bodies may refuse to do so because of lack of promulgation. The faulty State then incurs in a situation of international accountability.
	PROJECT OF LAW	Text presented by the Deputies or Parliamentary Group to the Parliament, so that the latter can pronounce on it.
	PROPOSAL OF LAW	Idem to Draft Law
R	RATIFICATION	Confirmation, authentication of an act or commitment: ratify a Treaty.
	REPEAL	Removing validity through a different rule. The repealed rule leaves the system, interrupting its force. The rule ceases to be valid, to belong to the legal ordering, and to have special relevance in dogmatic terms.
	REVALIDATION	Reposition in force of a previously revoked law (or legal precept).
S	STATE	Institution organized politically, socially and legally, occupying a defined territory, normally where the maximum law is a written Constitution, and rules by a Government whose sovereignty is acknowledged both internally and internationally. A sovereign State is characterized by the saying "One government, one people, one territory".
	STATE GENERAL BUDGET	Planning instrument that expresses Government Programs monetarily, in order for a financial exercise, discriminating the objectives and goals to be achieved by the Public Administration.

This incompatibility can be formal (lack of observance of the necessary rules for the process of legislative drafting or edition) and / or material (concerning the very content of the law or the normative act, and its conformity with the constitutional principles and rules).
