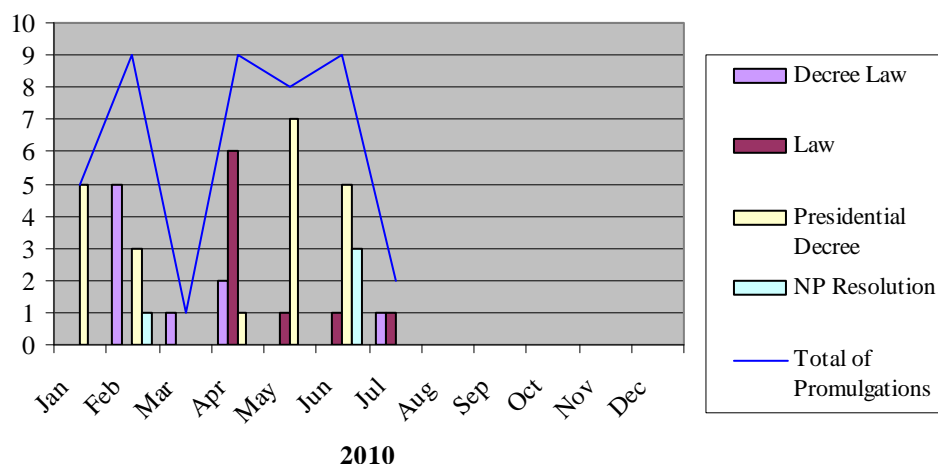

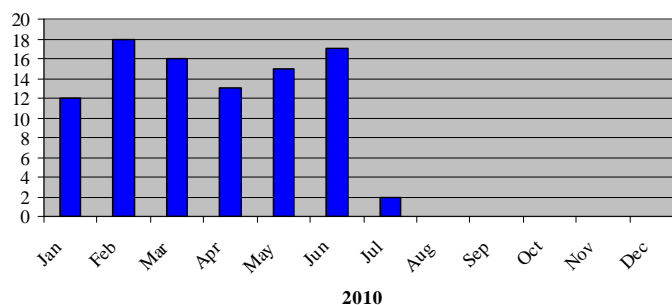

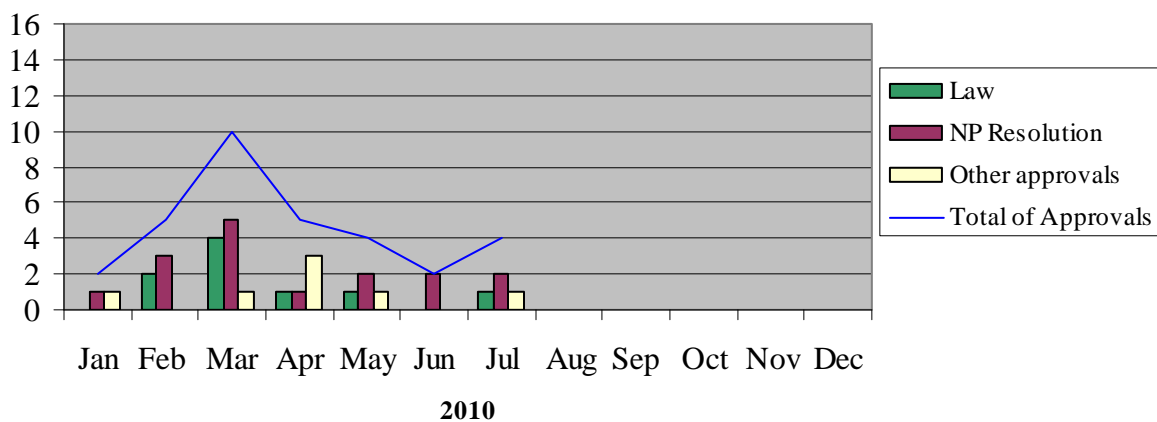

In July 2010, the National Parliament held five plenary sessions and two meetings of the Standing Committee<sup>2</sup> (21 and 28 July).

### **Main discussions and approvals**

  - Discussion and voting in specialty of the PPL 37/II (First modification to the Law 15/2009 of 23 December approving the 2010 General State Budget of the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste)

#### *Ministry of Education and Culture*

- Result: Approved with 42 votes in favour, 1 against and 16 abstentions

#### *Ministry of State Administration and Territorial Management*

- Result: Approved with 34 votes in favour, 17 against and 4 abstentions

#### *Ministry of Economy and Development*

- Result: Approved with 37 in favour, 19 against and 2 abstentions

### **Extraordinary Activities of the Parliament**

- 6-7 July 2010:
  - Consultations on the draft law to establish a Public Institute for Remembrance (“Instituto Público ba Memória”) and the draft law on the establishment of National Reparations Programme, organized by Committee A and several NGOs (STP-CAVR, Fokupers, HAK, ICTJ, JPC Dili, JSMP and NCD)
- 11-13 July 2010:
  - Women’s National Parliament Group<sup>6</sup> organized a conference on Reproductive Health, Family Planning and Sexual Education.

4. Ministry of Education not creating the necessary conditions for the training of teachers
5. MP Cornélio Gama (L-7) (UNDERTIM) complaint to the Plenary regarding the seizing of his car by PNTL

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<sup>5</sup> Recess period of the National Parliament started on 15 July 2010; according to Article 45 [Legislative Session] of the National Parliament Rules and Procedures: “(1) The legislative session has a duration of one year, beginning on 15th September and ending on 14th September of the following year; (2) The normal working period of the National Parliament begins on 15th September and ends on 15th of July, notwithstanding the period it is suspended at Christmas between 23rd of December and 2nd of January of the following year, and when Parliament deliberates it will be suspended by a two-third majority vote of the elected Members of Parliament.”

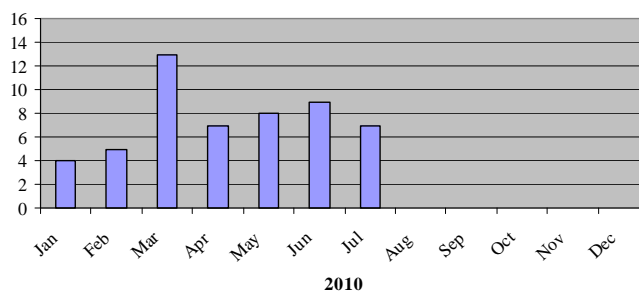
6. MPs expressed their sadness on the lack of respect shown towards MP Renan Selak (UNDERTIM), a veteran, in Los Palos District. MPs qualified the declarations made by PNTL Dili District Commander Pedro Belo against veterans as provocative and offensive; MPs asked PNTL General Commander Longinhos Monteiro and PNTL District Commander Pedro Belo to come to Parliament and present an official apology to the veterans. MPs also commented on Pedro Belo's background and pointed that he might be willing to create instability in the country
7. MPs suggested that Plenary sessions should be regularly broadcasted by TVTL
8. Information on the declaration from H.E. D. Alberto Ricardo da Silva, Bishop of Dili, regarding addressed to the President of the Women's National Parliament Group regarding the conference on Reproductive Health, Family Planning and Sexual Education which took place between 11-13 July 2010
9. Information regarding the Catholic Church perspective on the topic "Investing in Women's health is investing in Timor-Leste's bright future", presented by H.E. D. 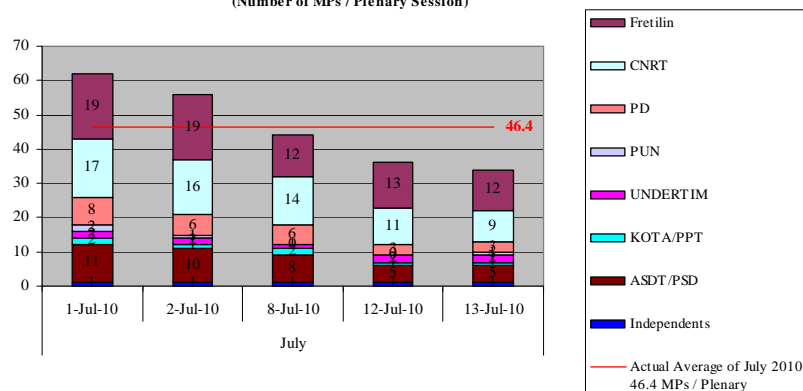

In addition, article 5 of the National Parliament Rules of Procedure states that. “A Member of Parliament who is to absent himself or herself for more than three consecutive days on substantiated grounds may, through his or her political party, submit a request for an early justification of absence and temporary replacement of office”.

<sup>8</sup> All information regarding official attendance in this section is based on the “Lista de Presença dos Deputados” prepared by the Secretariat of the National Parliament. The attendance data is based on the signature of the Member of the Parliament (MP) who signs the attendance sheet during a plenary session. Therefore, this does not mean that the MP attended the entire session. Statistics and analysis are made by DGSU/UNMIT.

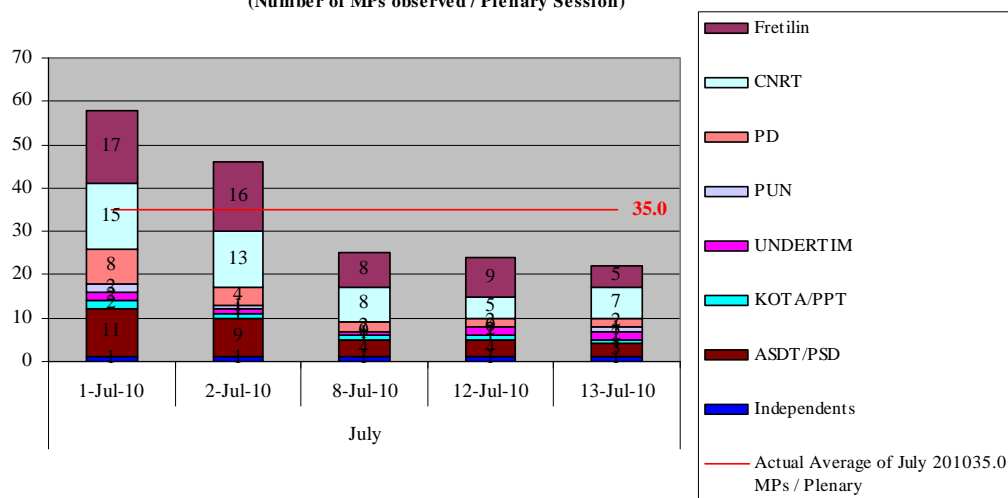

(Number of MPs observed / Plenary Session)



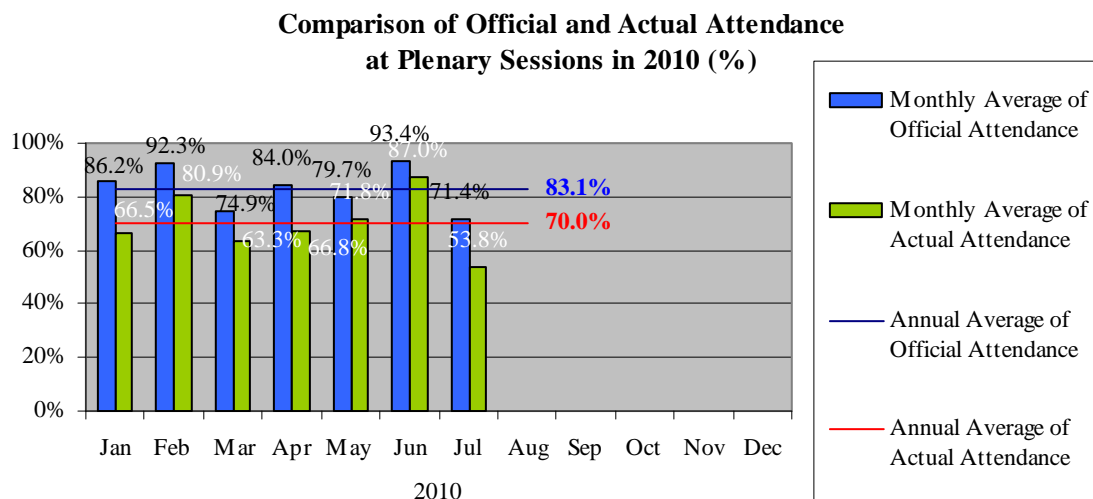

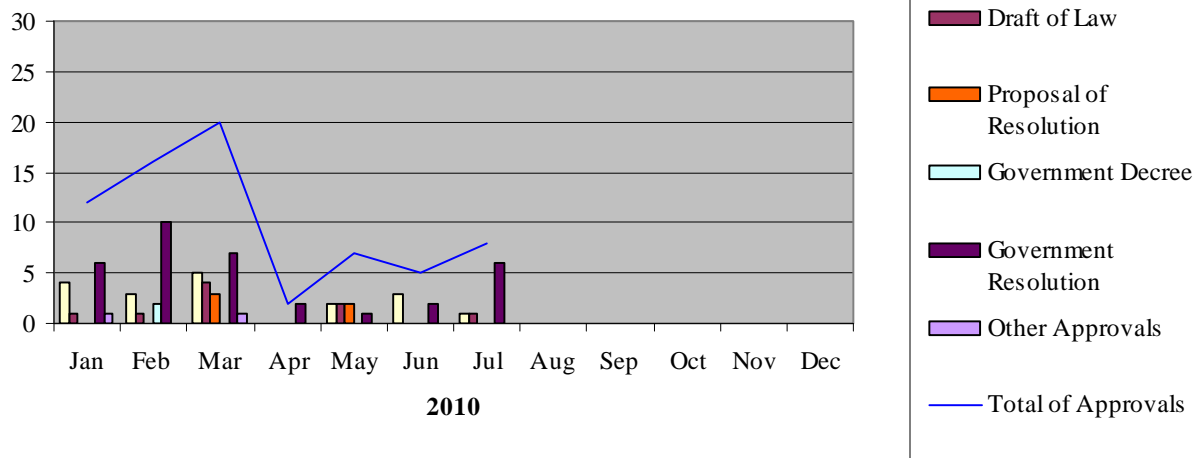

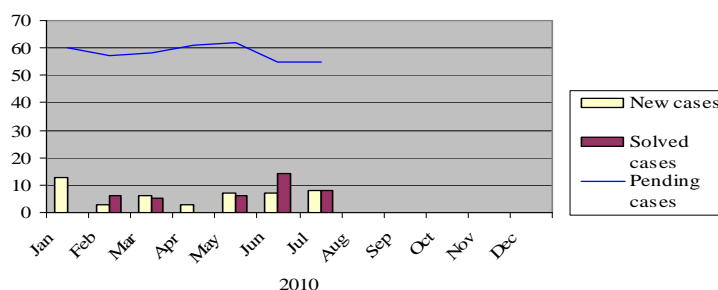

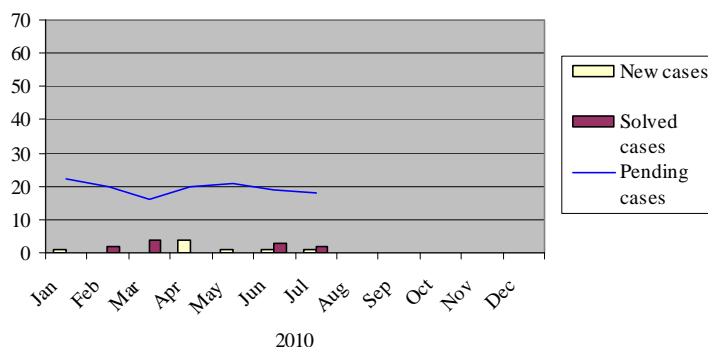
Penal Cases at the Court of Appeal in 2010

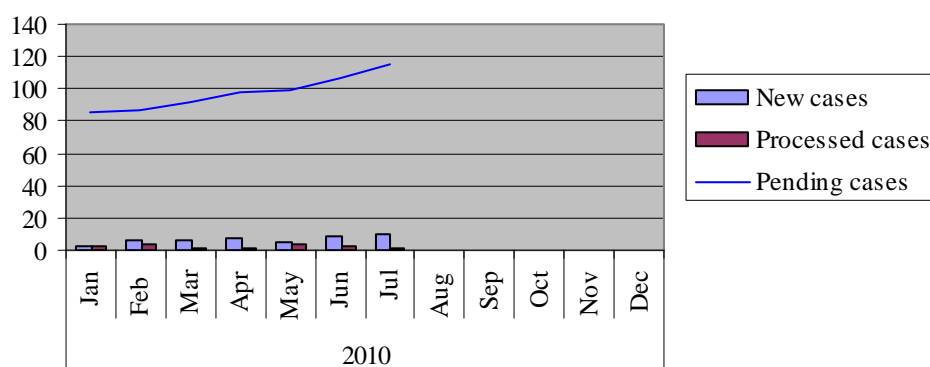

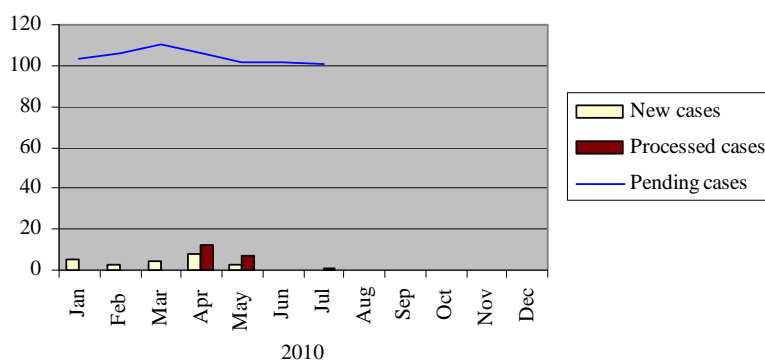

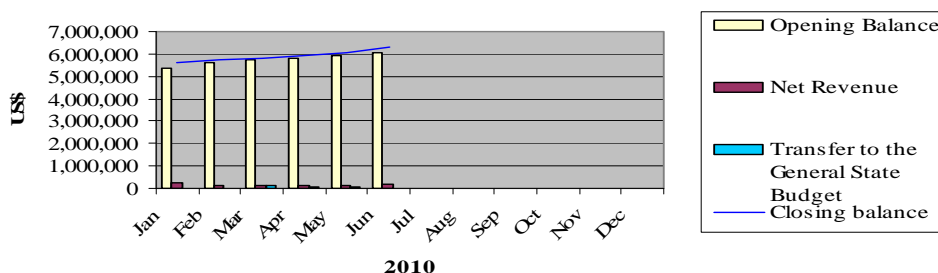

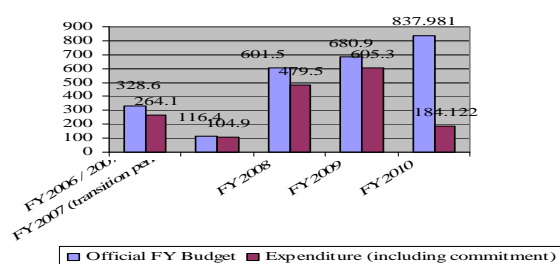
## STATE BUDGET EXPENDITURE AND EXECUTION RATE



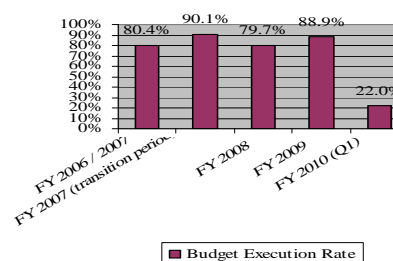

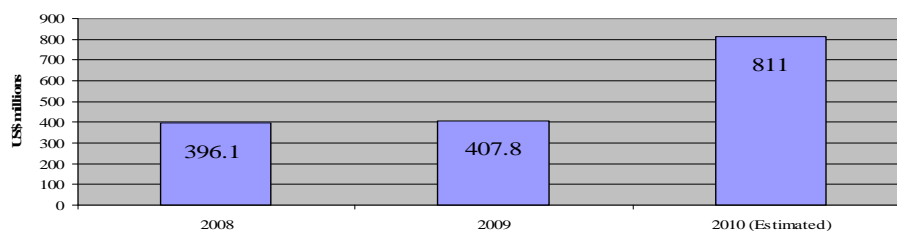
**State Budget and Expenditure**<sup>37</sup>

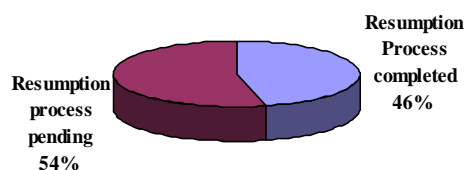

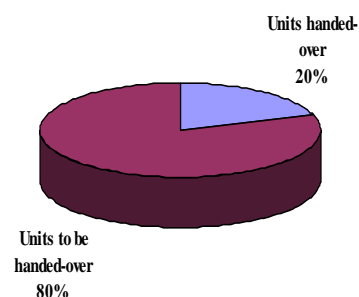

Status of Resumption Process - Districts

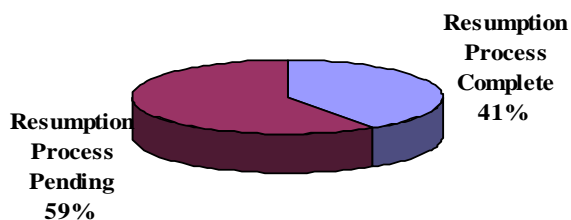


Status of Resumption Process - Units

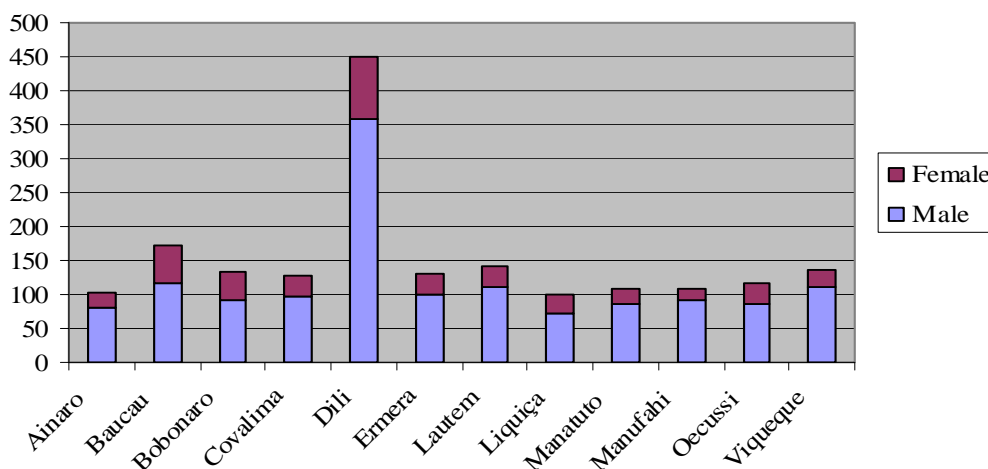


Status of Resumption Process – Number of PNTL officers (Districts and Units)

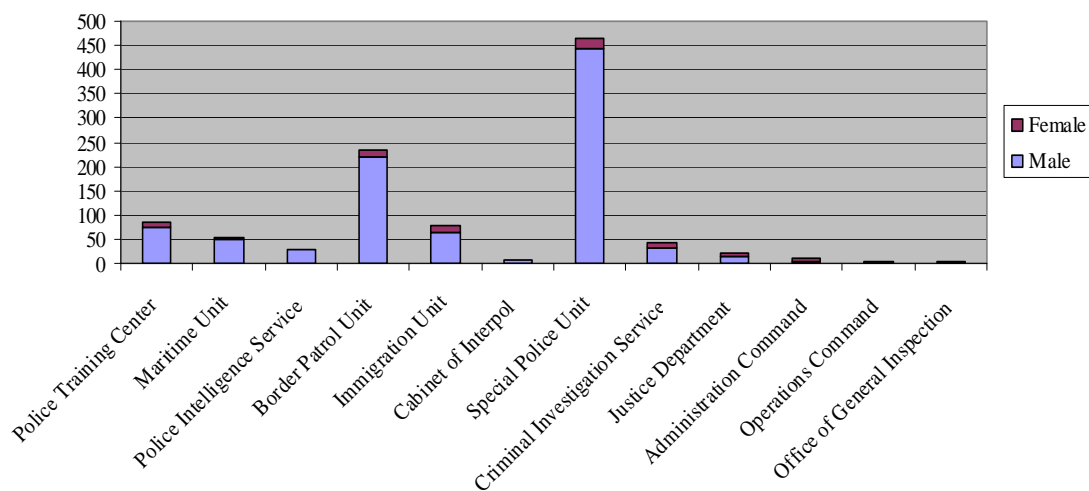

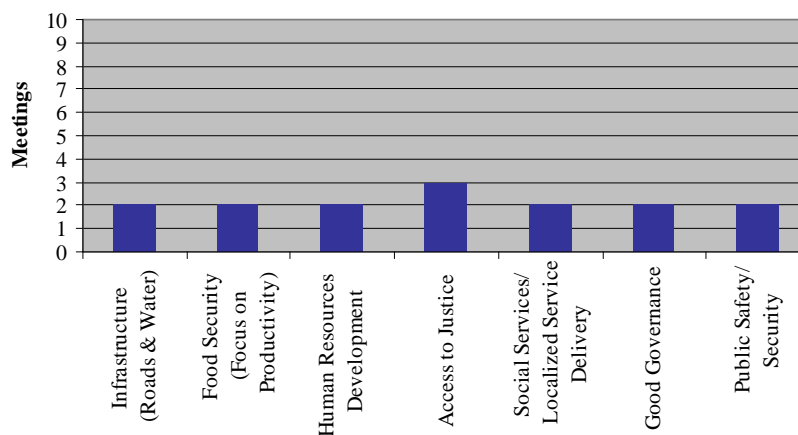

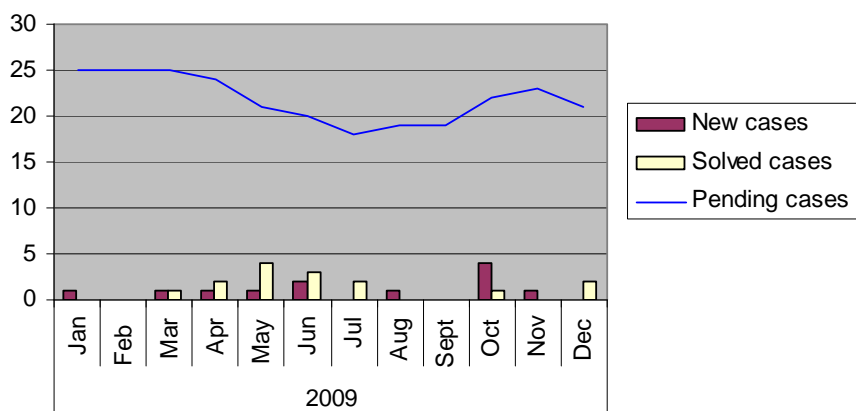

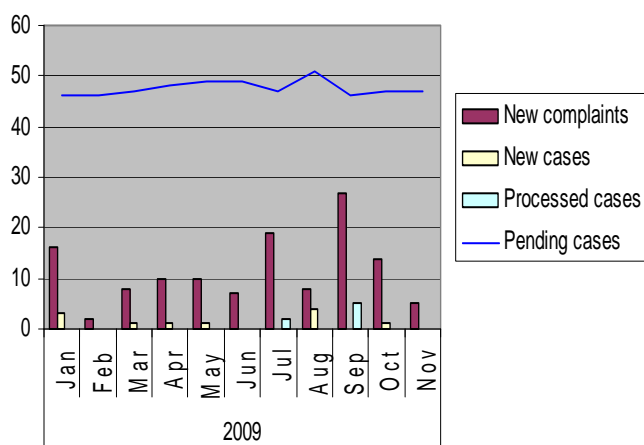

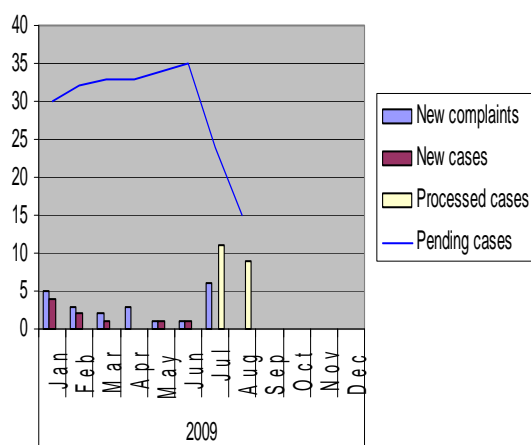

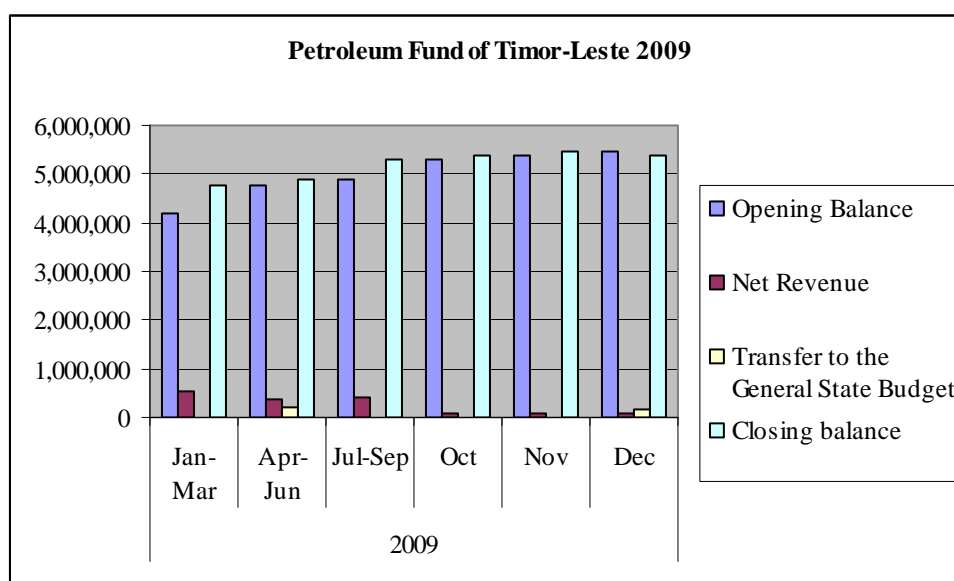

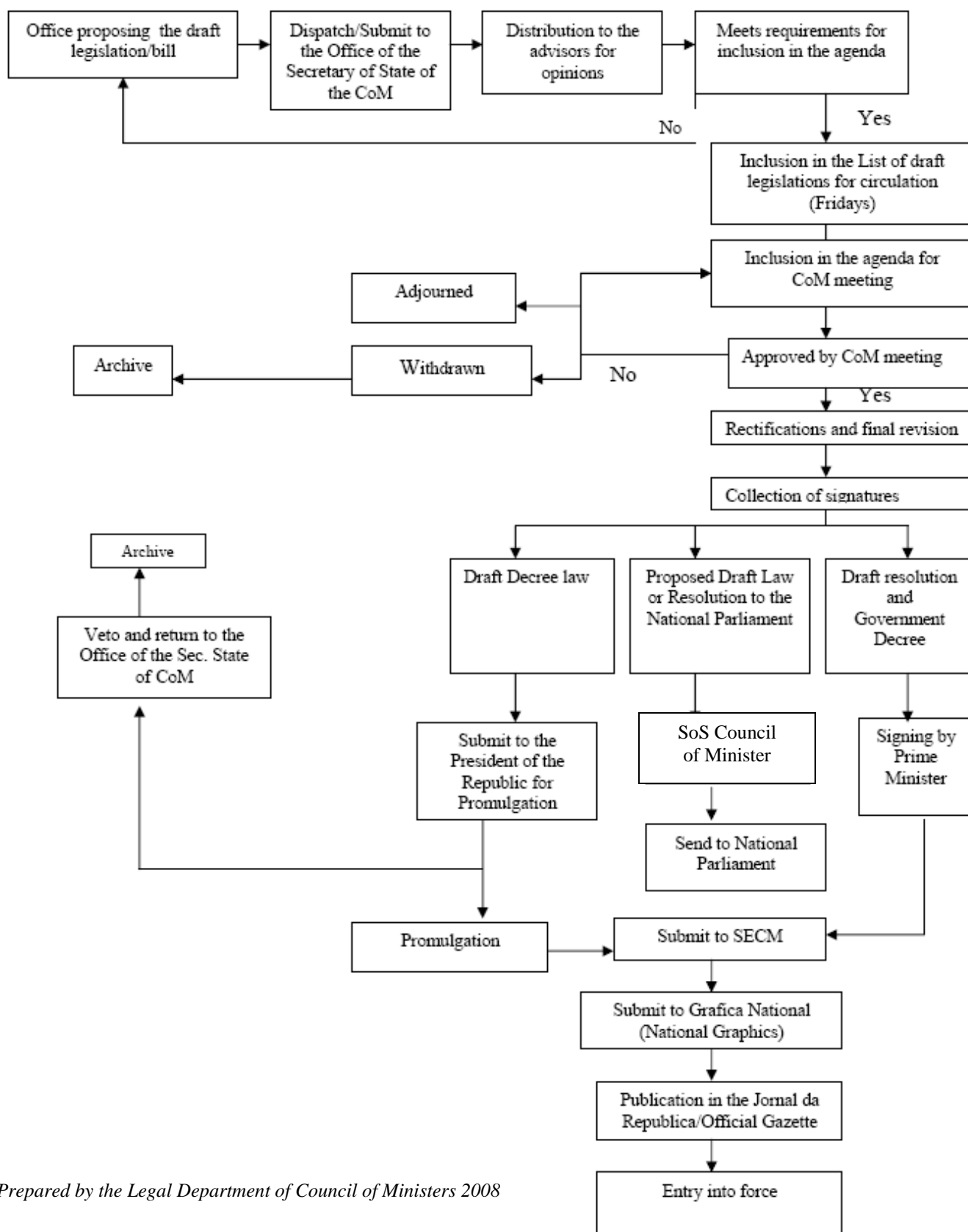

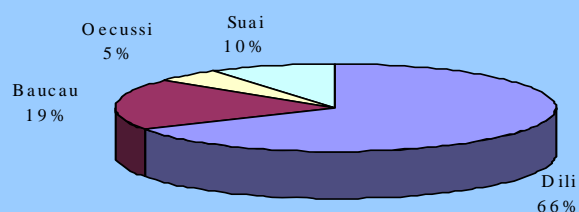

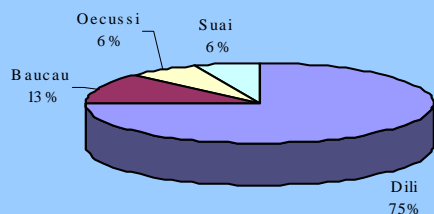

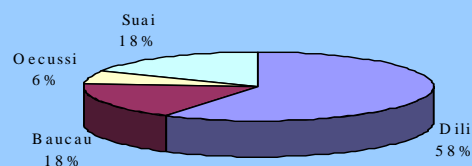
#### Allocation of National Judges by District Courts



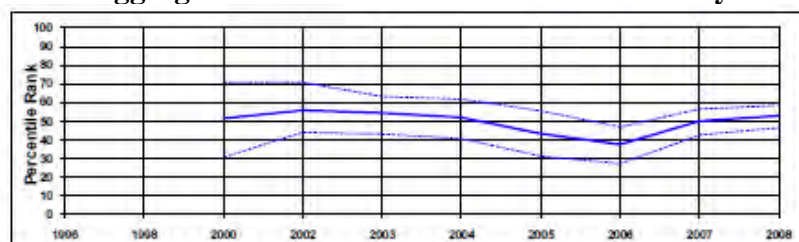
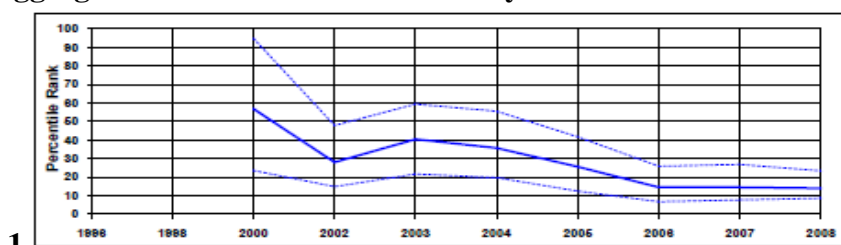
#### Allocation of National Public Defenders by District Courts



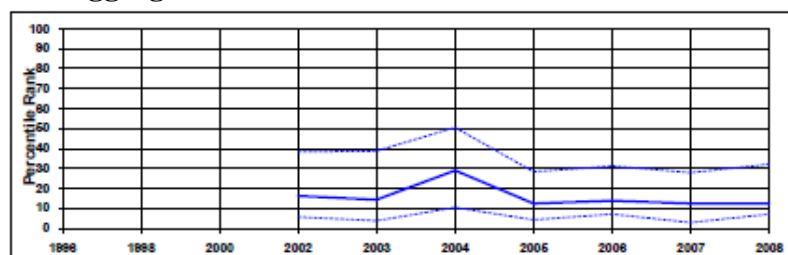
#### Allocation of National Prosecutors by District Courts

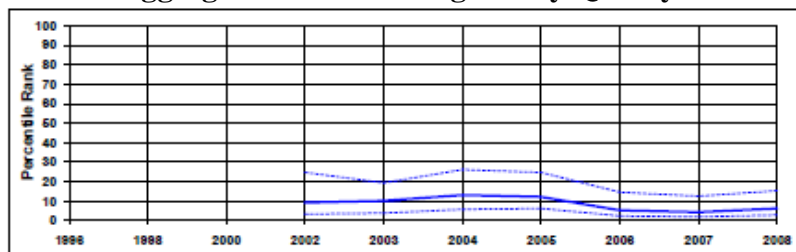

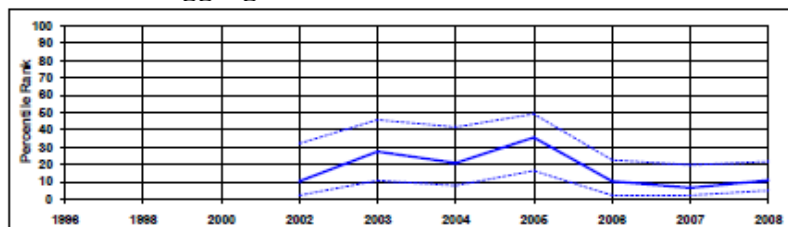

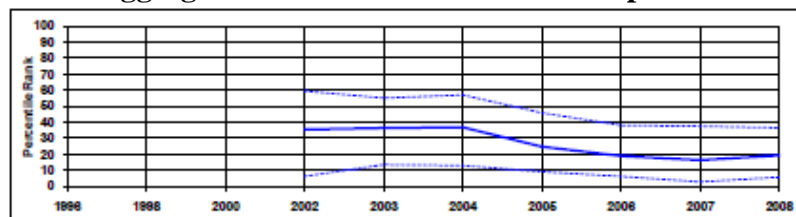
### Aggregate Indicator: Regulatory Quality<sup>78</sup>

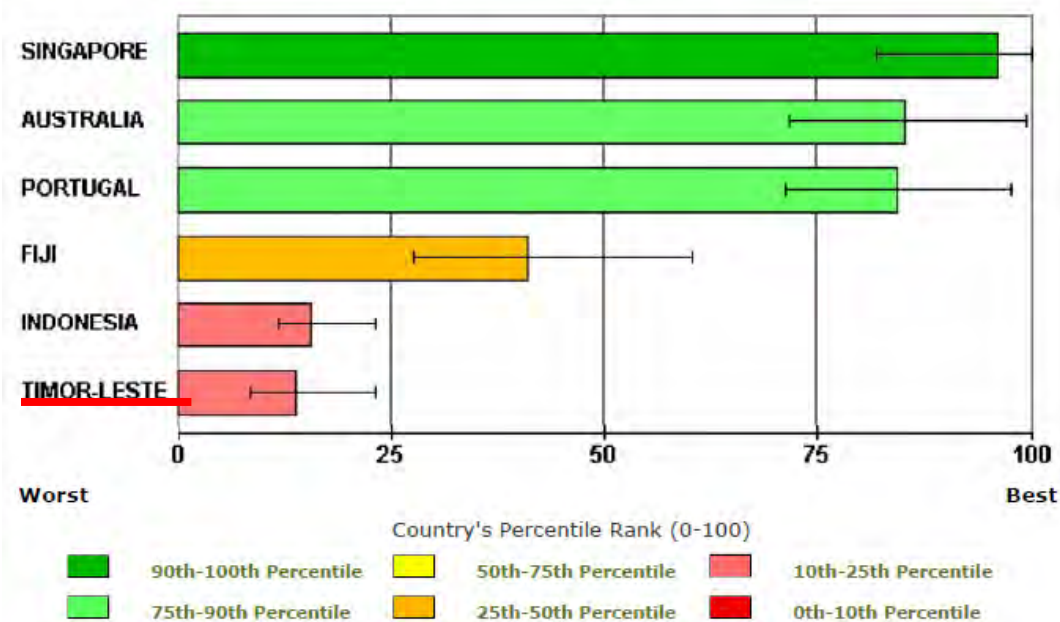

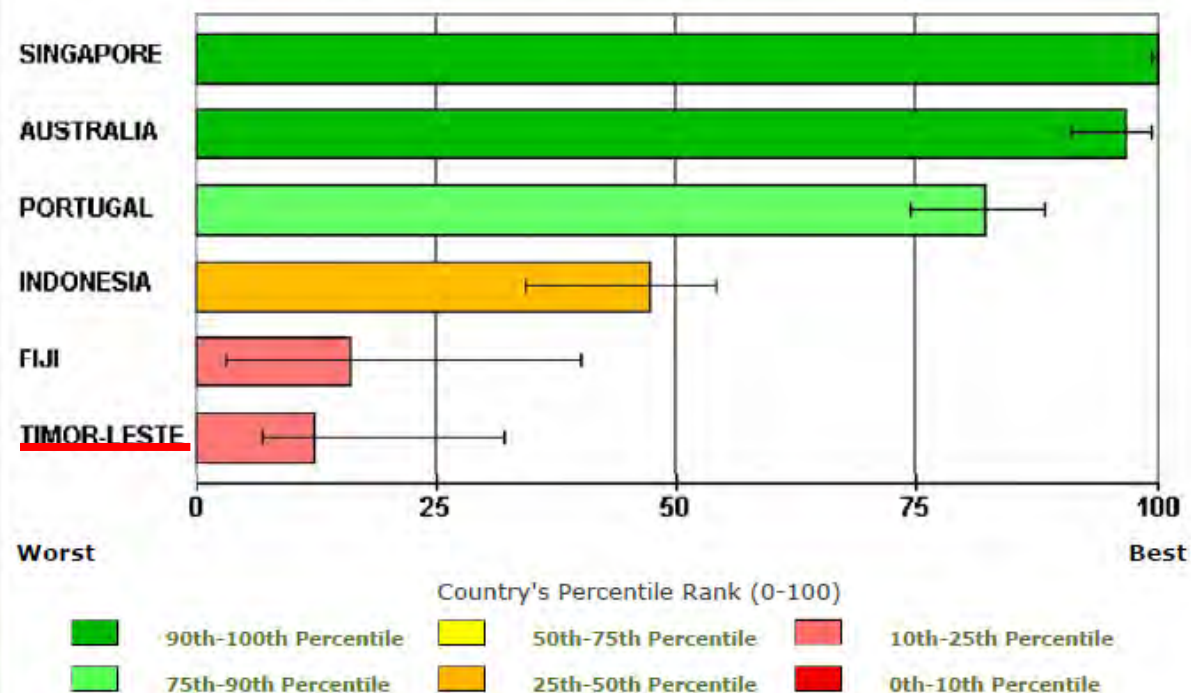

The legislative power elementary functions include that of overseeing the executive power and voting on budget laws.

It can also be defined objectively as the concrete and immediate activity that States develop for ensuring collective interests, and subjectively as the set of legal bodies and persons to which the Law attributes the exercise of the administrative function of the State. Under the operational aspect, Public Administration is the perennial and systematic, legal and</p>

		technical development of the services belonging to the State, benefiting the whole.
	<b>PROMULGATION</b>	Internal legal act by which the President of the Republic attests the existence of a duly ratified law, Decree-Law, treaty, etc., and order its execution within the territory. It is important to highlight the difference, in practical terms, between the effects of ratification and those of promulgation. If a State ratifies a treaty but does not promulgate it (and if its constitutional law requires promulgation), the conventional text is mandatory in the international sphere but not in the internal one. In this case, the State in question may be asked by other Contracting Parts to fulfill some of its conventional obligations, but one of its internal bodies may refuse to do so because of lack of promulgation. The faulty State then incurs in a situation of international accountability.

A sovereign State is characterized by the saying "One government, one people, one territory".
	<b>STATE GENERAL BUDGET</b>	Planning instrument that expresses Government Programs monetarily, in order for a financial exercise, discriminating the objectives and goals to be achieved by the Public Administration.
